

# **St. Philip Catholic School**

## **ADMISSION POLICY:**

**Eligibility for Attendance** - St. Philip Catholic School follows the State of Indiana's guidelines on school admission. At the present time, students must be five by August 1st to enter kindergarten that fall. Parents/Guardians may appeal to the principal of St. Philip Catholic School for early enrollment into kindergarten. Academic screening by the kindergarten teacher, a statement of readiness for kindergarten from the child's pre-school teacher, and an interview with the parents/guardians will be required for the appeal to be considered. Proof of age must be verified by a birth certificate. All students entering St. Philip Catholic School for the first time or entering grade 6 must have a physical examination.

## **SCHOOL ORGANIZATION:**

St. Philip Catholic School consists of pre-school through grade eight. Grades five through eight follow a departmentalized schedule. Kindergarten through fourth grades consist of self-contained classrooms. A two day pre-school program is available for three year olds. Four and five year olds are eligible for a three-day pre-kindergarten program. K-8 teachers are licensed by the State of Indiana.
